Mountain Logging, Inc. has been in the Clark family since 1967, and was founded by brothers David Sr. and Benny Clark. The family business was passed on through the generations and is now owned and



managed by Nicholas Clark. Nick started his career in the logging industry as a shop helper at age 16. When he was old enough to have a CDL, Nick hauled logs for Mountain Logging. Ethics is ingrained in leadership as well as its employees and exemplifies professional logging and road building at the highest quality while meeting or exceeding sustainable forestry objectives.

Mountain Logging operates on state, federal and private lands centered around the Columbia Gorge area near Bingen, Washington. Nick and his crew take pride in the results of sustainable forestry that is shared by the landowner in meeting land management objectives.

Mountain Logging has 30 employees of which 6 are Master Loggers recognized by Washington Contract Loggers Association (WCLA) as far back as 1998. The team will produce approximately 35 million board feet a year with 10 (plus) pieces of heavy equipment supported by 10 (plus) trucks to facilitate delivery to the local mills.
